



GPB CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

Fair Play

- Fair play is a huge part of this league as GP Bikes does not include an efficient penalty system. This means that us at Race Direction have to review each angle of footage if there is a relevant need to. As a rider, by reading these rules you have to maintain a level of maturity when riding so that other riders races aren't affected by the wrong-doings of yourself.
- Failure to provide a fair racing environment will lead to a disqualification and if you face 3 disqualifications you will be told to improve race-craft and if improvement isn't seen you will be banned from attending races.

Rider Regulations

- Use **MUST** use the dedicated suit located in the #requirements channel where you can download it.
- Please ensure you check the announcement channel before every race to make sure you have the required mods for each race.
- You **CANNOT** change numbers mid-season and an agreement will be made between us and yourself to ensure you are happy with the selection we provide.
- You will have to use the default liveries supplied within the mod to avoid plain bikes being seen on the live streams. (e.g. Jonathan Rea 2022 Kawasaki for SBK22 Mod)
- Make sure to select a preferred bike you would like to use when the announcement is given (the deadline for this decision will be a day prior to the race (Friday))
- In #requirements please download the essential mods so that the game doesn't break when you try to join.
- You **MUST** have a stable connection (25 Mbps or above) when participating in the championship.

Race Regulations

- If you have accidentally made contact with an opponent, briefly raise arm to display that the collision wasn't purposefully caused. The situation will be reviewed after the race IF appealed by a rider.
- If 3 or more riders are involved in ONE singular collision the race will be RED FLAGGED (will be displayed in chat). If this occurs after $\frac{2}{3}$ race distance, the results before will be used as the final results.
- Make sure to respawn when the track is clear so a bigger collision is not caused.
- The laps will be displayed in the #announcement channels before each race (MAX 25 MINUTE RACES)
- Please refrain from using in-game chat unless a severe incident has occurred on track or if you are experiencing a connection issue which could hinder other riders experiences.
- Qualifying format and Race format will change during different events please make sure to check announcements.

Penalties

- If you have overtaken a rider by going off-track you will be told to drop a position or you will be given a black flag.
- If you have blatantly taken out a rider you will be black flagged.
- If you have accidentally taken out a rider you will be given a 3 second penalty.
